

Application for Electronic Delivery of Notice

Pursuant to Texas Tax Code Section 1.086, on the written request of the owner of a residential property that is occupied by the owner as the owner's principal residence, the chief appraiser of the appraisal district in which the property is located shall send each notice required by this title related to the following to the email address of the owner:

- 1. A change in value of the property (notice of appraised value)
- 2. The eligibility of the property for an exemption; or

3. The grant, denial, cancellation, or other change in the status of an exemption application applicable to the property

Please note: a chief appraiser is not required to mail a notice if a request for electronic delivery is received by the appraisal office and a request for electronic notice will remain in effect until a written request to remove is provided by the owner.

Once the request has been processed, you will receive an email asking to confirm the electronic notice request.
